### Report:

#### **Background:**

As per the Municipality of Brockton's Purchasing and Procurement Policy, staff are required to report purchasing results over \$25,000.00 to Council for information purposes.

The Public Works Department issued an Invitational Competitive Process for the purchase of various sized (Outside Diameter) lengths of culvert (300mm, 450mm, 600mm, 800mm, and 900mm) for various 2021 projects throughout the Municipality of Brockton.

Three (3) quotes were received from Ontario Suppliers ranging from \$29,917.99 (+HST) to \$35,000 (+ HST).

The lowest quotation was from Atlantic Industries Limited (Ayr, Ontario) in the amount of \$29,917.99 (+HST).

#### **Analysis:**

The competitive quotations were all from very reputable Ontario vendors. Delivery of the culverts are due by the middle of June.
