## **MUNICIPALITY OF BROCKTON**

## GEORGE STREET RECONSTRUCTION

This notice is being issued to advise residents of the impending reconstruction on George Street between Durham Street and Orange Street in Walkerton. Reconstruction of the affected road section will include the following:

- Full road reconstruction and installation of curb and gutters;
- Sidewalk construction on one side of the roadway;
- Replacement of watermain and services;
- Replacement of sanitary sewer and services;
- Installation of new storm sewers.

A temporary potable water servicing is proposed to be installed at the lot lines for this project, as the existing watermains will be removed. Ramping will be provided by the Contractor where water lines must cross streets or driveways. Individual water services will be installed along the ground to each house and after the temporary water system has passed the required testing and disinfection, a temporary connection will be made to an outside hose bib/tap to provide potable water service to each property. Please ensure that the outside hose bib/tap on your house is functional and accessible. If you do not have a functioning or accessible outside hose bib/tap please notify the Municipality immediately, as alternate arrangements may have to be made to provide temporary water service to your property.

Once construction has begun, no on-street or boulevard parking will be permitted within the construction zone for the duration of the project. Parking will be permitted on adjacent streets.

Access to driveways may at times be restricted and not always available depending on the construction activity.

Prior to construction, property owners are advised to remove any planting beds (i.e., flowers, shrubs, hedges, etc.), any underground sprinkler systems, any heated driveway systems, and any fencing from the boulevard of the road allowance and relocate them onto their private property.

Garbage and recycling bins should be put out at the roadside, as usual. The Contractor will ensure that the garbage and recycling are collected. It is requested that residents write their address on the outside of the bins to ensure they are returned to the correct address.

There will be disruptions to the water system while the temporary connections and permanent connections are being made. You will be advised in advance of these disruptions.

Sanitary services will be replaced, but there will not be any inconveniences experienced by the home owners.

There are no planned service disruptions to Hydro, Cable or Communications.

Emergency Services are aware of the works.

It is anticipated that the road closure will occur between June and September, 2021, beginning on Friday June 18th and extend for a period of approximately 8 weeks. George Street will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the project – access for local traffic will be permitted, however may be restricted during certain components of the project.
