Dear Brockton Council,

I am writing to you today to request assistance with purchasing a flagpole and a Brockton Flag, to fly at the Saugeen Municipal Airport. Currently the airport does not show representation from our supporters, Municipality of Brockton, Town of Hanover and the Municipality of West Grey and I feel that it is important to show our guests and neighbors, from near and far, our union and strength as a supportive community, for our local airport.

Currently the airport flies the Canadian Flag at the terminal building and stands approximately 20 feet high. Due to ground space availability at the terminal building, we are proposing to fly the three town flags at the main entryway into the airport, near the airport road sign, located at the intersection of Airport Road and Saugeen Airport Road. The thought is to enhance the appearance with landscaping alongside the three flag poles.

We have reached out to a Canadian company for the flag poles, but we would also be willing to work with your provider as well. Ideally, we would like all three flag poles to be of the same height, colour and brand, to keep the look in unisons. We would place the Brockton Flag in the middle, with The Town of Hanover Flag on one side and the Municipality of West Grey Flag on the other side. We would be willing to work with you regarding protocols or Bylaws you have in place for your flag, and we look forward to your response with this joint venture!

We are requesting funds in the amount of \$1000.00.
