Recommendation:

That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby approves Report Number REC2021-28 – Request for Rebate Arena Advertising Panel Invoicing, prepared by Mark Coleman, Director of Community Services and in doing so, directs staff to process a ____% rebate of fees for advertising panel clients for the COVID-19 closure periods of the Walkerton Community Centre April 2020 through May 2021.

Report:

Background:

The Walkerton Community Centre and Arena provides advertising opportunities to local businesses and organizations in the form of wall panels within the arena visible to facility users, spectators, community events/rentals. Advertising fees and rates within the Fees and Charges By-law helps generate revenues supporting facility operations while promoting services and economic development within Brockton.

Our total advertising revenues for wall panels:

2020 having 15 one year and 4 three-year contracts = \$7,792.28

2021 having 18 one year and 10 three-year contracts = \$13,639.83

Staff have received inquiries and comments from about 6 clients requesting consideration of a rebate or refund in lieu of the facility closures where their businesses were not realizing the potential advertising exposure and benefits. Many of our business advertising clients have remained supportive of the Walkerton Community Centre throughout the pandemic. Some of these businesses may have experienced economic decline or losses as a result of the uncertain times of the pandemic. The total amount of time the Walkerton Community Centre was closed due to the COVID-19 lockdowns from March 2020 to May 2021 was about 5 months. The following example is offered for Council's consideration:

Example: a 20% rebate of fees/invoicing for the time period closed would equate to:

2020 = \$1,126.66 2021 = \$1,641.29

Total = \$2,767.95 refund

Analysis:
