By-Law 2018-094

Being a By-Law to Prescribe Speed Limits for Motor Vehicles Being Driven On Certain Portions of Highways in the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton.

Whereas the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, C. 32 Schedule D, Section 128 (2), as amended, and the *Municipal Act, 2001* R.S.O 2001, as amended, authorize Municipal Councils to pass by-laws to regulate and control traffic;

And Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton deems it expedient that the speed of motor vehicles on certain highways in the Municipality of Brockton be restricted;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows:

- 1.0 The highway known as Old Durham Road from the intersection of Ontario Road to Duke Street is marked in compliance with the regulations under the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O 1990, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be forty kilometres per hour.
- 2.0 The penalties provided in Section 128 (14) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O 1990, as amended and shall apply to offences and contraventions of this By-Law.
- 3.0 This By-Law shall be referred to as the "Old Durham Road Speed Limit By-Law" and shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
