Consent Application Notice

A change is proposed in your neighbourhood: The purpose of the application is for a lot addition. The application proposes to sever an approximately 13.6 m2 parcel from the subject property and convey it to the adjacent property to the south. An associated zoning by-law amendment will provide a special zone for the subject property and the property being enlarged to recognize a reduced interior side yard setback of .97 metres for both properties. 
Know your rights

Section 53(19) of the Planning Act outlines rights of appeal for Consent applications.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the County of Bruce in respect of the proposed consent does not make written submissions to the County of Bruce before it gives, or refuses to give, a provisional Consent, the Ontario Land Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.
