Report:

Background:

Under the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002, Ontario Regulation 30/11 outlines the prescribed costs for various Care and Maintenance fees that the Municipality needs to collect. Section 166 of this Ontario Regulation specifically outlines the costs that are put into the Care and Maintenance Trust for the installation of monument or marker based on the size.

Analysis:

The Ontario Regulation 30/11 was updated with new prescribed costs for Care and Maintenance portion of the installation, including:

Monument / Marker Type	Current Cost	New Cost
Flat Marker – measuring less than 173 square inches	\$0	\$0
Flat Marker – measuring more than 173 square inches	\$50	\$100
Upright Monument less than 4 feet in height or width	\$100	\$200
Upright Monument more than 4 feet in height or width	\$200	\$400

Staff are seeking Council's approval to update By-law 2021-134 – 2022 Fees and Charges By-law to be in line with the new fees as per Ontario Regulation 30/11.
