## 4. Reports

## 4.1 Planning Report – Minor Variance – A-43-18.34 Scherders – Prepared by John Ghent, Bruce County Planner

John Ghent presented his revised Planning Report dated October 9, 2018. John Ghent explained that the Committee of Adjustment had approved a minor variance to reduce the applicable MDS setback from 564m to 240m. The Applicant was proposing to build a house with a setback of 198m and not the 240m that had originally been recommended by John Ghent. A revised site plan had been submitted by the Applicant prior to the last meeting on September 24, 2018, but planning staff were not aware of the change in the setbacks. John Ghent confirmed that the revised distance of 198m and not 240m would still satisfy the required tests and constituted good land use planning.

# 4.2 Planning Report – Minor Variance – A-51-18.31 Elphick– Prepared by Mark Paoli, Bruce County Planner

Mark Paoli, Senior Bruce County Planner presented his Planning Report dated October 9, 2018. Mark Paoli explained that the minor variance application would allow the applicants to build a shed to store equipment. The proposed location of the shed would allow for trucks to turn around and maintain sightlines to the barn. The applicants were proposing that the applicable setbacks be reduced from 20m to 4m. Mark Paoli confirmed that, in his opinion, the application did satisfy the required test and he recommended that it be approved.
