







Calls for Service of Note

Traffic

South Bruce OPP started and ended the month of May with arresting individuals for Impaired Driving offences – arrests were made on May 1st and 2nd as well as May 30th.

The middle of the month presented a Stunt Driving charge – an 18 year old male driver was charged with driving twice the posted speed limit, travelling at 161 km/hour in a posted 80 km/hour zone on Highway 9.

South Bruce OPP has partnered with Perth County OPP and Huron County OPP to establish a long weekend Traffic team. Each Detachment has committed two members who will work together over the summer long weekends to target our identified high traffic volume corridors. The first weekend the team worked together was the May Long weekend. This resulted in increased visibility as well as enforcement resulting in increased public safety on our roadways for all three Detachment areas. Over 500 charges in total were laid over the long weekend with over 100 of those being in the South Bruce area.

Trespassing

South Bruce OPP officers while out along the trail became aware of some individuals camping in the area. Officers worked with By Law as they served Trespass Notices on the individuals for camping on Municipal land.

Detachment Updates

We would like to congratulate Tim EVANS and John HARDY who were the successful candidates in our recent Sgt competition. Sgt EVANS is already a member of South Bruce OPP and started his new assignment immediately. Sgt HARDY is joining us from Huron County OPP and will transfer in June.
