1. Call to Order

She added that a celebration will be held at the Airport on August 20, 2022 with a display of special aircraft, cake and vendors. The Vice Chair noted that the Hanover Chamber of Commerce will hold its July meeting at the Airport, when the Airport Manager will make a report to the Chamber and food will be served by the restaurant.

C. Friends of Saugeen Municipal Airport

Jack Zeinstra reported that a meeting was held on Saturday, June 11, 2022. Upcoming events include Kids Can Fly on August 20, and additional meetings will be held to organize other events. He noted that an article about the group written by the Airport Manager appeared recently in the Hanover Post and the In-Flight Broadcasting Information System has been delayed due to a shortage of computer chips and is expected to be installed in the fall.
