#### **Background:**

The Walkerton-Hanover Veterinary Clinic provides services to the Municipality with respect to the Municipal Dog Control By-Law 2020-082. Presently, the services provided by the Walkerton-Hanover Veterinary Clinic have been provided without a formal agreement in place.
