Background:

To update and provide information to Council on Site Plan Control Approvals and development within the Municipality of Brockton as site plan control approval has been delegated to Municipal staff as stipulated by Provincial Bill 109.

Analysis:

The proposed development is for 11 Unit row townhouse development at 11 Devinwood Ave within the Walker West Estates subdivision. Municipal Staff and B.M. Ross as our engineering consultant have reviewed the proposed development for conformity with Municipal standards and by-laws and are of the opinion that the proposed development meets the required Municipal standards and by-laws for the purposes of Site Plan Control Approval.

A Site Plan Control Agreement has been authorized by Municipal Staff who have been delegated authority for entering into Site Plan Control Agreements by Brockton Council.

Municipal staff continue to review and work with other development proposals for Site Plan Control Approval. Staff will continue to work closely with our developers in advancing municipal development approvals and site

plan control while ensuring that all necessary requirements have been fulfilled prior to approval. Continued updates will be brought to Council for information purposes.
