## 9. New Business

9.1 2023 Budget

The Committee discussed the proposed 2023 Budget, with the following amendments:

- 1. Mileage of \$500.00 should be included for Committee Members travelling to Cargill where the collection is being stored;
- 2. Ensuring appropriate funding for the murals to be continued in the next year;

- 3. Although the initial doors open event was paid for, the Committee supported allocating \$7500 to allow for the groundwork to be performed to plan for an event in 2024, such as an external graphic designer or potential contract person. It was noted that the Committee may also be able to approach local businesses for corporate sponsors of the event.
- 4. It was noted that staff could inquire about the potential for the juried art show given that the Brockton Art Committee did not have sufficient volunteers.
- 5. The Committee included \$1500 for the publication of a new cordwainer book.
- 6. The amount budgeted for training and seminars remained at \$500.00 as additional Integrity Commissioner training may be required.
- 7. The amount of rent was reduced and any increased expenses to the facility in Greenock would be evaluated for 2024.

The Committee then considered potential new projects for consideration in 2023, including considering bringing in a speaker or researching how to designate a neighborhood, or hosting a workshop on completing heritage repairs.
