By-Law 2023-004

Being a By-Law to Repeal the Council Remuneration By-Law.

Whereas, Section 283(2)(b) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, allows that a municipality may only pay the expenses of the members of its council or of a local board of the municipality if the expenses are of those persons in their capacity as members if the expenses are, in lieu of the expenses actually incurred, a reasonable estimate, in the opinion of the council or local board, of the actual expenses that would be incurred;

And Whereas Section 283 (7) of the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended allows that on or after December 1, 2003 a council shall review a by-law under Section 283 (5) at a public meeting at least once during the four-year period corresponding to the term of office of its members after a regular election;

And Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton appointed the Council Remuneration Review Committee to review and recommend remuneration levels for the 2018 to 2022 Council Term and the Committee presented their recommendations to Council on December 11, 2017;

And Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton approved the Committee's recommendations by way of Resolution 18-02-017 on January 22, 2018 and further approved Resolution 18-10-162 on May 14, 2018 approving a "grossed up" remuneration option, should the Federal government move forward with the removal of the one third (1/3) allowance;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton adopted a Council Remuneration By-Law 2018-060 on July 23, 2018 setting the remuneration for Council members for the 2018-2022 Term;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton has now included Council Remuneration within the Salary Administration Policy, and wishes to repeal the former Council Remuneration By-Law;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows;

- 1.0 That the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton Council hereby repeals By-Law 2018-060.
- 2.0 This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 3.0 This By-Law may be cited as the "Repeal Council Remuneration By-Law".
