Being a By-Law to Amend By-Law 2020-052, Being the By-Law to Regulate and Control Traffic and Parking Within The Municipality of Brockton.

---

**Whereas** the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8*, as amended, and the *Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, S.O. 2001*, as amended, authorize Municipal Councils to pass by-laws to regulate and control traffic.

**And Whereas** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton deems it expedient to pass a by-law to regulate and control traffic within the Municipality of Brockton.

**And Whereas** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton desires to amend its existing Traffic and Parking By-Law 2020-052.

**Now Therefore** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule “A” to By-Law 2020-052, being the schedule for “Stop Signs”, be amended to include the following intersection where a stop sign shall be erected;

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3
Sideroad 20	North Side of Bridge Street (Riversdale Bridge)	South

2. That By-Law 2022-082 by hereby amended.
3. This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
