


Background:


To provide an annual statistics report on Building Department Activity for Council's information purposes.


Analysis:


A total of 208 Building Permits were issued in 2022 with a total Estimated Value of Construction of \$44,435,613.20. Residential Construction accounted for approximately 50.5% of all permits issued. Septic permits accounted for 16.8% of all permits issued while Agriculture type permits accounted for 15.9% of all permits issued. A total value of \$335,595.15 was collected for Building Permit Fees in 2022. Building Inspections completed in 2022 totaled 867 and 143 Building Permits were closed for permits issued between 2018 to 2022. A 5-year comparison of Building Department Statistics has been included for Council's information purposes. Identified is a slight decrease in 2022 for building active compared to statistics from 2021. While overall as part of the 5 year comparison 2022 activity numbers approximately double the Estimated Value of Construction and Permit Fee Collection from the years 2019 and prior.
