That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number BCCC2023-01 – Brockton Child Care Centre Closing due to Training, prepared by Sharon Bross, Brockton Child Care Centre Supervisor/RECE, for information purposes and supports the March 24, 2023 training day for Brockton Child Care staff.

### **Report:**

#### **Background:**

The Ministry of Education initiated the Canada-Wide Early Learning and Child Care System Funding (CWELCC) program which includes supporting professional development training as well as lowering child care fees. The first professional learning day was October 28, 2022 which was attended by 250 Child Care educators held at the Cargill Community Centre. Brockton Child Care staff participated in this training. Operators can apply to the County of Bruce for funding to off-set lost revenue. Lost revenues, wages for additional staff (i.e. supply staff not scheduled daily) and mileage for staff to attend will be covered.

#### **Analysis**:

The Counties of Bruce, Grey, Huron and Stratford are arranging a second professional learning day to be held at the Blue Mountain Resorts on March 24, 2023. This will require closing the Centre and School Age Programs so all educators are able to attend the training sessions. Families will not be charged for March 24, 2023. Families will be given advance notice of closure of the programs.

We support the ongoing training of our staff and the opportunity to provide this to ensure ongoing quality child care. We bring this closure to Council's attention for information purposes.
