Background:

In December 2022, Council received a donation request from the Mildmay Junior Moose and Twisted Sisters Juvenile Broomball to help fund their trip to the 2023 Juvenile Broomball Nationals in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan March 29 – April 1, 2023.

Analysis:

According to the Municipality of Brockton’s Donation Policy F19-1999-05, a review of the request has been completed. The following chart illustrates the eligible donation amount for the organization. This request is for both the girls and the boy’s broomball team, which both qualified for the National Championship in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan.

Mildmay Junior Moose Broomball and Twisted Sisters Juvenile Broomball	2 – Organization’s head office is located outside of Brockton but in Bruce County and the funds will benefit the citizens of Brockton and other municipalities in the County	\$300.00
