And Whereas s. 4(1) of the *Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990 c. P. 15* states that every municipality to which the section applies shall provide adequate and effective police services in accordance with its needs.

And Whereas the local population has already been subject to acts of violence by repeat offenders released on bail, up to and including death of innocent people and injuries to our police officers.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton calls on both the Federal and Provincial governments to implement changes to bail schedule to assure incarceration while awaiting trial of accused individuals likely to re-offend or participate in other criminal acts.
