## **Recommendation:**

That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number PW2022-05 – 2023 Tenders for Product and Services – Calcium Chloride and Crushed Gravel, prepared by Nicholas Schnurr, Director of Operations, and in doing so accepts the 2023 tender results and awards contracts to the following lowest bidders:

- A.) Calcium Chloride: Den-Mar Brines Inc. for \$324.09/ tonne = \$71,299.80, excluding HST. As well as Da-Lee Dust Control Ltd as a secondary contractor on an as needed base
- B.) Crushed Gravel (Crush and Stockpile): Joe Kerr Limited: at \$ 3.10/ tonne, excluding HST.
- C.) Crushed Gravel (Crush and Apply): Joe Kerr Limited: at \$10.40/ tonne = \$312,000, excluding HST.

And further, the Municipality of Brockton shall have the option to renew the contracts for up to two (2) additional one (1) year periods.

## **Report:**

#### Background:

Each spring, the Public Works Department prepares and submits "Request for Tender" (RFT) for various Products and Services. The closing date of the tender was Wednesday, February 8th, 2023 at 1:00pm. Nicholas Schnurr, Director of Operations, and John Strader, Operations Manager, opened the tenders.

In 2022, the Municipality paid \$272.92/ tonne for Calcium Chloride; \$4.65 per tonne for crush and stockpile and \$9.65 for crushed and applied gravel (approximately 30,000 tonnes).

## Analysis:

Staff recommends that the Council of the Municipality of Brockton accept and award the contracts to the lowest tenders, Den-Mar Brines Limited for \$324.09/tonne of Calcium Chloride and Joe Kerr Limited for \$3.10/

tonne of crushed and stockpiled gravel and \$10.40/ tonne of crushed and applied gravel. In addition, the Municipality would like to enter into a "standing offer contract", as outlined in the RFP document with the two lowest priced successful bidders. The lowest priced Successful Bidder will be issued a purchase order for the initial requirement in the Scope of Work. Thereafter, the Municipality may directly issue purchase orders to either contractor, as selected by the Municipality, for future requirements under \$20,000. For future requirements valued at \$20,000 and over, the Municipality shall request quotes from the two (2) contractors and a purchase order will be issued to the contractor with the lowest priced quote. The Municipality shall have the option, but not the obligation, to renew the contracts for up to two (2) additional one (1) year periods.
