Recommendation:

That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number CLK2023-11 - June 2023 Council Meeting Location Change, prepared by Sarah Johnson, Deputy Clerk and Fiona Hamilton, Director of Legislative and Legal Services (Clerk) and in doing so ratifies the decision to change the meeting location for the June 6, 2023 Meeting to the Bruce County Council Chambers and the June 20, 2023 Meeting to the Cargill Community Centre.

Report:

Background:

On September 20, 2022 staff brought forward Report CLK2022-24 outlining the 2023 Council Meeting dates and locations, including two meetings that would be held in the hamlet communities of Cargill and Elmwood to accommodate residents. The calendar was circulated to all Council members, and the community through the website, social media, and the Brockton Buzz newsletter.

Analysis:

Staff have invited representatives from Bruce County to attend the June 6, 2023 Council Meeting to present on the Durham Street Bridge replacement, and in order to accommodate a wider audience within the Walkerton community who will be impacted by the bridge replacement should they wish to attend in person, staff decided to change the meeting location to the Bruce County Council Chambers at 30 Park Street, Walkerton and the June 20, 2023 Council Meeting to the Cargill Community Centre at 999 Greenock-Brant Townline, Cargill.

Staff have confirmed the meeting location change with the County of Bruce and the Cargill Community Centre to ensure the booking is available. Staff have also updated the meeting location information on our website, and communicated the change to the public on social media. A revised calendar has also been posted at the

Post Office and Municipal Office bulletin boards to replace the original calendar with the updated June 2023 Meeting locations.

As no other delegations were scheduled for the June 6th or June 20th Council Meetings, staff recommended changing the locations to accommodate this opportunity for Council and members of the public to hear an update from the County of Bruce regarding the Durham Street Bridge.
