Report:

Background:

On April 29th 2023 staff received the attached request from Saugeen Artists Guild to waive the fee of \$40.00 for the use of the Brockton pavilion.

Analysis:

Saugeen Artist Guild is a non-profit organization with the head office located in the Town of Hanover. They provide an inclusive environment in the Saugeen Watershed community where people of all diversities can experience and value the arts. Members are able to network with other artists and market their work. The membership offers mentoring program, workshops, guest speakers, friendships and inspiration from one another.

Saugeen Artists Guild is hosting our second Plein Air Festival July 19- 23, 2023. On July 21st, the Saugeen Artists Guild is planning on using the Cargill pavilion as one of their highlighted locations. The day will include a visit to the village of Cargill to paint the mill pond, visit the Cargill Gallery, café and ice cream wagon.

Provided there is no additional staff needed as the request is for the use of the outdoor pavilion, and minimal financial impact, staff recommend that Council approve the request to waive the \$40.00 rental fee for the pavilion.
