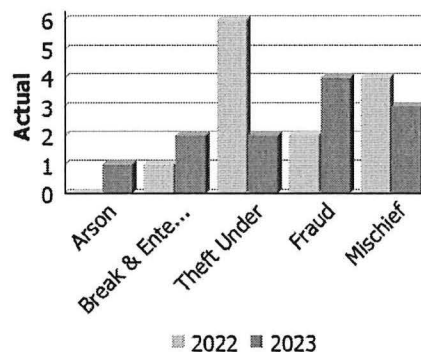

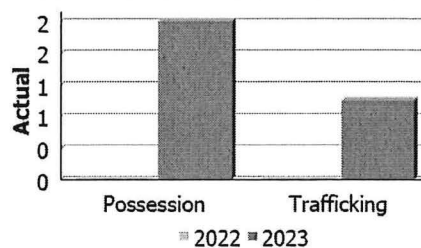

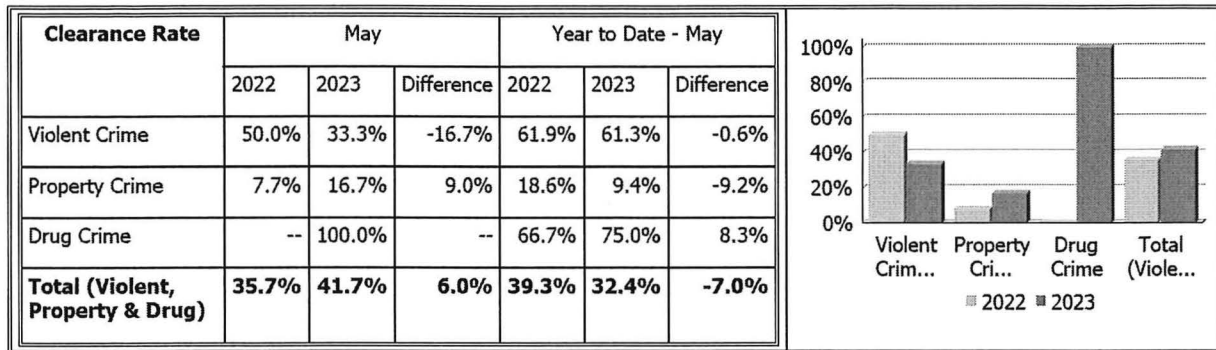

## **Calls for Service of Note**

### ***Violent Crime:***

Assaults – There were 2 assaults investigated during the month of May. One of the assaults occurred during a domestic dispute and the other occurred during a dispute at an unwanted person call for service.

### ***Property Crime:***

Break and Enter – 2 break and enters were reported during the month of May. 1 of the break and enters was reported at a Municipal Landfill site. The e-waste container was entered and various e-waste electronics were stolen. That investigation is on-going. The other break and enter was in relation to a domestic dispute where charges have been laid.

Fraud – There were 4 frauds reported during May. All 4 of the frauds were considered cyber fraud. In one of the cases over \$25,000 was paid to an unknown source. That investigation is on-going. In 2 of the remainder of cases no money was exchanged as the complainants identified that it was likely fraudulent.

### ***Drug Crime:***

As a result of an extensive investigation conducted by the Community Street Crimes Unit, 2 search warrants were executed in Brockton. The warrants were executed with the support of the Community Street Crimes Unit (CSCU), Tactics and Rescue Unit (TRU – Central and West Teams), Emergency Response Team (ERT) and OPP Canine. Officers arrested and charged 2 individuals and have seized the following items as a result of the investigation: Approximately \$18,000 in controlled substances and a quantity of offence related property which includes a cross bow, a 12-gauge shotgun, brass knuckles, scales and cell phones.

### ***Traffic:***

Impaired Driving – Officers apprehended 3 impaired drivers in May of 2023. 1 of the impaired drivers was apprehended at a RIDE check. 1 of the impaired drivers was apprehended as a result of a domestic dispute investigation and the 3<sup>rd</sup> was apprehended as a result of a motor vehicle collision.

Traffic Enforcement / Education – Over the month of May, officers issued 108 Provincial Offence Notices for a variety of Provincial Offences. Further to this, they issued 69 formal warnings for a variety of Provincial Offences.

Canada Road Safety Week – Officers participated in the Canada Road Safety Week traffic safety initiative that was established to address the big 4 causal factors in serious collisions on OPP roadways. During the weeklong initiative officers charged drivers for the following offences: 94 speeders, 5 fail to wear seatbelts, 1 careless driving, 1 stunt driving, and 1 fail to stop for a school bus.

### ***Other:***

Crime Stoppers – 0 tips specific to Brockton were received from Crime Stoppers in the month of May

Foot Patrol – 38.25 hours of Foot Patrol were dedicated over the 1 month period in Brockton.

MCRT – MCRT supported detachment members and responded to 26 mental health related calls for service. Of these 26 calls for service, 22 of them were diverted away from an apprehension and the hospital. MCRT continues to be a vital component to our detachment and the program continues to demonstrate positive impacts on the community.

***Detachment Updates:***

PC Brad Ferguson was the successful applicant for a position within the Protective Services Section within the OPP. PC Ferguson started in his new position at the end of May. PC Ferguson has been a valued member of the South Bruce OPP Detachment for a considerable amount of time. We wish PC Ferguson all the best in his new role.
