By-Law 2023-070

Being a By-Law to Amend By-Law 2020-052, Being the By-Law to Regulate and Control Traffic and Parking Within The Municipality of Brockton.

**Whereas** the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8*, as amended, and the *Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, S.O. 2001*, as amended, authorize Municipal Councils to pass by-laws to regulate and control traffic.

**And Whereas** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton passed By-Law 2020-052 to regulate and control traffic within the Municipality of Brockton on April 28, 2020.

**And Whereas** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton passed Resolution 23-09-06 on April 11, 2023 with the goal to consider the installation of a Pedestrian Crossover located on South Street connecting the sidewalk on Robinson Street to South Street to allow individuals to safety cross over to South Street.

**And Whereas** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton desires to amend its existing Traffic and Parking By-Law 2020-052.

**Now Therefore** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule “B” of By-Law 2020-052 be amended to include the following Uncontrolled School Crossings:

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3
Cemetery Road	East side of intersection at Hinks	Signage posted each side
South Street	East side of intersection at Robinson	Signage posted each side

2. That Schedule “G” to By-Law 2020-052 be amended to remove the Restricted – No Stopping along South Street in order to install the Uncontrolled School Crossing at the intersection of Robinson and South Streets in Walkerton:

Column 1 Street	Column 2 Side	Column 3 From	Column 4 To	Column 5
<del>South Street</del>	<del>South</del>	<del>Robinson Street</del>	<del>30 meters east of Robinson</del>	<del>8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.</del>

3. That Schedule “I” of By-Law 2020-052 be amended to include additional parking spots designated exclusively for the use of disabled persons who have been issued and clearly display in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act and the regulations thereunder a disabled persons parking permit:

- xvii. Two (2) spaces, being the first two (2) parking spots, located on the East side of the Market Garden fronting north of the alleyway between Colborne and Victoria Streets in Walkerton.

4. That By-Law 2022-082 by hereby amended.

5. This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
6. This By-Law may be cited as the “Amend Traffic and Parking By-Law (Market Garden Accessible Parking and Robinson/South Street Crosswalk)”.
