Report:

Background:

For a number of years EPCOR has been diligently working to bring natural gas to the community of Brockton. We are pleased to report EPCOR has now applied for the leave to construct natural gas pipelines in the Municipality of Kincardine, the Township of Arran-Elderslie, the Municipality of Brockton and the Municipality of West Grey. This application will see the largest number of residents served in the Brockton area.

Analysis:

The Ontario Energy Board Notice is attached as is the OEB package for Council's information. As outlined on the Notice there are various ways to participate and obtain information related to this project. One of those ways is by seeking intervenor status. I recommend the Municipality file to become an Intervenor with a position of support and even inclusion to comment on the need for natural gas in the community and to support stage 1 and 2 of the proposed project. This will allow us to be in a position to offer arguments of support, ask questions of the OEB related to the application to construct in Brockton should there be a number of intervenors that file that may be opposed to the project advancing.

With Council approval we will file for intervenor status by the August 14th deadline.
