Report:

Background:

Brockton Parks and Recreation has an ongoing working relationship with the Bruce Grey Catholic District School Board where each party extends the use of resources, such as facility space to the other with the understanding that this exchange benefits both parties.

There is currently no reciprocal agreement in place with Bruce Grey Catholic District School Board. Staff reached out to the administration to establish a proper agreement like we have with Bluewater District School Board.

Analysis:

The reciprocal agreement maximizes the use of public infrastructure; reducing facility operating costs; strengthening relationships between school boards and community partners and the public. This agreement improves the level of service and support that recreation can offer to the community and alternatively provides more opportunities and support to the students. There are many different activities that Brockton offers through the use of the schools within Brockton, such as, Dodgeball in the gymnasium, fitness classes should we need additional space, possible cooking classes, etc.

Attached is the updated agreement is consistent with our agreement with Bluewater District School Board, which is also being reviewed for a new agreement to come forward to Council in the near future. The attached agreement with BGCDSB is from September 2023 to August 31st 2026.
