### Report:

### **Background:**

In 2022 the Cargill District Community Foundation (CDCF) became an independent not for profit corporation. Their vision being "To be a leader committed to charitable needs." In March of 2023, CDCF donated \$5,000 to the Municipality of Brockton. \$2,000 was used for a cement pad for the garbage dumpster and \$3,000 was used to upgrade the steel roof on dugouts.

#### Analysis:

In October of 2023, CDCF gave \$50,000 to various community programs and clubs. The Municipality of Brockton was fortunate to be presented with a \$9,500 donation for the purchase of mulch within the Cargill playground and to replace boards and to repair 25 picnic tables.

As we know in 2024 Cargill will be celebrating homecoming where increased volume of usage will take place at the playground where it has been recommended in playground inspections to increase and replenish mulch to improve safety. Picnic tables will be a necessity as many families will socialize and enjoy the park area surrounding the community centre. Staff will not only replace boards to repair existing picnic tables but will ensure a percentage of tables are made to meet accessibility requirements. The Municipality of Brockton would not be able to make these upgrades without the support and generous donation from the CDCF. We thank them for this donation and the outstanding contributions they have made within our community.
