Report:

Background:

Broadband Internet Access in the rural areas of Brockton is a concern for local business operators and residents. This was further identified through the Business Retention & Expansion Project (BR & E). As Council is aware and stated by FCM "reliable Internet connection is not a luxury; it's a necessity. Businesses need it to innovate, compete and grow. It is vital to public safety and public services—and to Canadians' everyday quality of life."

Reliable, fast internet makes the local business community competitive and keeps them thriving and located in in Brockton.

Analysis:

The Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) is launching a campaign "Reliable Internet for Everyone" a national broadband strategy. They are calling for clear targets for speed, long-term, predictable funding, and affordable access for the hardest-to-serve populations. They are seeking the support and promotion by municipalities across Canada. This is a larger problem than we can tackle alone. Participation would be consistent with the Action Plans outline in the BR & E.
