Recommendation:

That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number PW2024-01 – East Ridge Business Park Tender, prepared by Nicholas Schnurr, Director of Operations & Sonya Watson, Chief Administrative Officer and in doing so awards the contract to Kurtis Smith Excavating Inc. in the amount of \$1,670,800.00 plus HST.

Report:

Background:

The East Ridge Business Park is one of Brockton's biggest investments into future development, showcasing some of the finest business growth locally and attracting new businesses to the area. As ongoing development continues, additional stages of servicing are required. The next phase has been designed and tendered for construction in 2024.

There were six (6) tender submissions. B.M. Ross and Associates reviewed all tender submissions for completeness and accuracy and provided the Municipality with a letter of recommendation. That letter of recommendation is attached to this report. B.M. Ross and Associates is recommending that the Municipality award the contract to Kurtis Smith Excavating Inc. in the amount of \$1,670,800.00 plus HST.

Analysis:

Staff have budgeted for this project in the 2024 municipal budget, this tender is in line with the estimates for this project. The project will be funded from the Infrastructure Ontario Construction Loan, as well as ongoing sales proceeds from the lots within the ERBP area.

Staff are supporting the recommendation from B.M Ross and Associated for the contract to be awarded to Kurtis Smith Excavating Inc. in the amount of \$1,670,800.00 plus HST. Work is scheduled to be completed by

August 30, 2024. We will be further launching our marketing campaign for these lots upon approval of the construction tender.
