Report:

Background:

On January 30th, 2024 staff received the attached request from Cole Dales, committee member of the Battle of the Badges Committee requesting waiving the ice rental fee and auditorium rental fee.

Analysis:

The Battle of the Badges is one of many wonderful events taking place at the Walkerton Community Centre on February 19th, 2024 as part of the Family Day events. This will be the third annual event and has always been well attended and loved by the community.

Since January 30^{th,} 2024 staff have confirmed and discussed with Cole that the auditorium and Special Occasion Permit (SOP) are in the Walkerton Jr. C Capitals name and the rental will be part of their regular season game ice/auditorium rental fee.

Staff recommend that Council approve waiving the ice rental fee, in the amount of \$150 for the Battle of the Badges event that is taking place on Family Day.
