Report:

Background:

On April 23rd, 2024, report Elmwood Homecoming Sponsorship Request, prepared by Trish Serratore, Chief Financial Officer was brought to Council. It was noted that the Elmwood Homecoming Committee has not requested any financial assistance towards the cost of Homecoming event, including no request for seed money to assist with the financial planning. The donation request is for activities and events occurring throughout the duration of the weekend, proceeds raised will allow for the community to continue events like this and support other community initiatives. Council requested that staff obtain more details on the sponsorship opportunities and the recognition process for donations.

Analysis:

Following the April 26th, 2024 Council meeting staff communicated with Elmwood Homecoming Committee to provide a more defined donation request. The Elmwood Homecoming Committee responded that they are seeking a \$500 donation to help contribute towards celebration activities such as a kid's zone where families can be entertained by inflatables, balloon fun and more, a fishing derby, cornhole tournament, car show, nightly dinner and dances, baseball tournament and more. The committee would appreciate any financial support the Municipality can contribute.

The Elmwood Homecoming Committee submitted a donation letter to the Elmwood Community Centre Committee requesting a discounted rental rate. During the May 14, 2024 Elmwood Committee meeting the committee approved a discounted flat rate of \$2000.00 for rental fee's for duration of celebration.

The Elmwood Homecoming Committee have submitted a sponsorship request to the Municipality of West Grey that will on the agenda for May 21, 2024 Council meeting.

The Elmwood Homecoming Committee recognition process for donations is presented as Sponsorship packages, see attached document. A \$500.00 donation is a Bronze Level Sponsorship offering a recognition of donation sign displayed on main stage and fence by main area and referenced in Bronze Sponsorship social media posts.
