#### **Background:**

On May 23, 2024 staff received the attached request from the South Grey Bruce Youth Literacy Council to waive the fees for the October 19, 2024 event.

On March 5, 2024 Council approved a \$300 donation to the South Grey Bruce Youth Literacy Council as part of their annual request.

### **Analysis:**

On October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024 the South Grey Bruce Youth Literacy Council will be hosting their first event in many years called Funky for Literacy. The request is to waive the fees for the rental space at the Cargill Community Hall, including the stage for the local band. The total value of the request is, \$610.20 including HST.

Staff are seeking Councils direction on the request as this would be the second financial support request in 2024.

Option 1 – waive the fees for the Funky for Literacy day

Option 2 – send our regrets as Brockton provided \$300 in March 2024

There is nothing noted in the Donation Policy F19-1999-05 about multiple requests each year. As per the donation policy, the South Grey Bruce Youth Literacy Council would be eligible for up to \$150 gven that the

organizations head office is outside of Bruce County. They are a "Factor One" – the requesting organization's head office or chapter is located outside Bruce County, and some of the funds will be used to benefit the citizens of Brockton.
