Report:

Background:

In accordance with the Municipality of Brockton's Procedural By-Law, staff have compiled a draft calendar of the 2025 Council Meeting dates.

Analysis:

Council Meetings

The meetings have been scheduled for the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the Bruce County Council Chambers, unless specified.

Two dates have been determined for off-site meetings at the Cargill Community Centre (June 24, 2025), and Elmwood Community Centre (September 9, 2025) to accommodate Brockton's rural residents. These dates have been confirmed with both the Cargill Community Centre and Elmwood Community Centre.

Staff are proposing that the Council Meetings continue to be held in hybrid format accommodating both inperson meetings at the Bruce County Council Chambers, and virtual participation through Zoom Video Conferencing and eSCRIBE livestreaming.

Only one Council Meeting will be held on the third Tuesday of the month, being March 18, 2024 to allow for vacation around March Break occurring the week of March 10-14, 2025.

The one Council Meeting in July will occur on the third Tuesday of the month being July 15, 2024.

The November Council Meetings have also been adjusted to occur the first and fourth Tuesdays of the month due to Remembrance Day falling on the second Tuesday of the month.

2025 Budget Meetings

Three (3) Special Meetings have been scheduled to consider the 2025 Municipal Budget on Thursday, January 23, 2025, Friday, January 24, 2025, and Tuesday, February 11, 2025.

The ROMA Conference is occurring the week of January 19-21, 2025 so the Budget Meetings have been moved to later that week (January 23rd and 24th) to accommodate members of Council travelling back from the ROMA Conference.

Staff are proposing that the Budget Meetings on January 23rd and 24th occur from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Bruce County Council Chambers. The third Budget Meeting is proposed to occur on Tuesday, February 11, 2025 at 1:00 p.m. followed by the Council Meeting at 7:00 p.m. both at the Bruce County Council Chambers.

Staff are recommending that Council approve the attached 2025 Council Meeting Schedule.
