4. Business Arising from the Minutes

Electrical Upgrades

E. Falkiner reviewed electrical quotes for electrical upgrades at the Elmwood Community Centre.

Three quotes were obtained, see attached.

Willies Electrical \$3850 +HST

Lang's \$7902.44 including HST.

Richardson \$10816.06 +HST

The cost of the upgrade will be from the Operating Budget.

Parking lot expansion - Board to complete a scope of work before B. Thomson can get quotes, will require three quotes. B. Thomson requires size and what material they would like.

6. Ongoing Business

6.1 Lions Park - Upgrade Ideas

Surface will need to be removed in order to upgrade the courts. The basketball net could not be left up if the court was surfaced for pickleball.

- B. Thomson shared a park design.
- Main cost for project is drainage.
- U10 Pitch, picnic tables, could be completed by staff and staff could assist with the pathway.
- Pickleball courts and playground will be outside company, can use the current playground and add on to it.
- Staff to look for senior grants for pickleball courts.
- Drainage will be required to be completed first.
- E. Stangler has volunteered to get a quote for drainage for the park (farm drainage company he works with).
- Trillium grant comes out yearly, may be able to apply for soccer pitch and drainage.
- Garbage pail is at Lions Park already and porta potty is to be delivered by June 1st.
- Board members discussed adding a basketball, K. Hewlett discussed if the board decides to add in future, it is a simple and low-cost project. Board members discussed possibly adding a basketball court to Elmwood Community Centre.

- Picnic shelter is structurally okay but could use a little face lift upgrade such as paint.
- Brockton to keep an eye for any upcoming Grants for the Lions Park.
- B. Thomson discussed self-watering planters that Walkerton has started using and mentioned that Elmwood could look into purchasing in the future.

6.2 Heat Study Load

No update currently, defer to next meeting.

6.3 EV Charger Location

C. Gillis discussed the location of the EV Charger, went back to the previous minutes, and did not find a lot of discussion in relation to why the location was picked. C. Gillis discussed with Willie why the location charger was placed where it is.

Lang's priced out to move to edge of sidewalk and build around to make sidewalk wider. Provided a quote for this work \$11 823.04.

Willie provided a quote to move EV charger to parking lot with bollards, will lose one parking spot. The quote was \$4500.

Relocating the charger is a capital project, will require approval from both councils. West Grey and Brockton to take report to council.

That the Elmwood Community Centre Board request the Municipality of Brockton and Municipality of West Grey fund the relocation of the EV Charger due to accessibility and health and safety concerns, to a maximum of \$5000 combined as an unexpected capital expenditure.

7.2 Elmwood Homecoming 2024 Request

C. Gillis updated that she has met with Elmwood Homecoming Committee to go over their plans.

Elmwood Homecoming Committee has requested a small donation from Municipality of Brockton and Municipality of West Grey, they did not request any seed money.

Elmwood Homecoming committee submitted a request for a reduction in fees for 2024 Homecoming.

Board members discussed options for reducing rates. Prices for Homecoming dates:

- Ball diamond Friday to Sunday \$120+HST/day
- Hall Friday Monday \$495+HST/day
- The hall is not being used Wednesday or Thursday tent is going in parking lot on Wednesday most likely at request of tent company.
- Pavilion Friday to Sunday \$110+HST/day

Monday is cleanup day.

60% of revenue from Homecoming has been allotted to go back to the community.

Total at full rate is \$3100+HST Wednesday and Monday as set up days, Thursday to Friday full day rental rates.

That the Elmwood Community Centre Board charge the Elmwood Homecoming 2024, \$2000+HST Wednesday August 28, 2024, to Monday September 2, 2024.
