Consent Application Notice

A change is proposed in your neighbourhood: The purpose of the application is a Consent to sever a +/-0.87-hectare (ha) surplus farm dwelling from a +/- 20.5-ha agricultural parcel. Through the Zoning By-law provisions (Section 5.2), if approved, the severed lands will be recognized as a non-farm lot, the agricultural lands will be prohibited from establishing a new residential dwelling and the reduced lot area of +/-19.6-ha is permitted, a holding provision will also be applied in areas of high archaeological potential.

Section 53(19) of the [Planning Act](#) outlines rights of appeal for Consent applications.

Only the applicant, the Minister, a specified person (being a utility and transportation company) or a public body may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT).

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the County of Bruce in respect of the proposed consent does not make written submissions to the County of Bruce before it gives, or refuses to give, a provisional Consent, the Ontario Land Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.
