Recommendation:

That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number BCCC2024-05 - Brockton Child Care Centre Expand Sandboxes and Construct Sunshades, prepared by Sharon Bross, RECE, Brockton Child Care Manager and in doing so approves proceeding with the contract for the Outdoor Shade Structure in the amount of \$10,400 plus HST.

Report:

Background:

In 2021, the Bruce-Grey Catholic District School Board completed significant renovations to the Brockton Child Care Centre playgrounds, which included the addition of sandboxes. There are two sandboxes currently at the centre, one at each playground. Since these renovations, the Centre has experienced a substantial increase in enrollment, leading to higher demand for the sandboxes. Unfortunately, the current size of the sandboxes limits the number of children (approximately 5-8 children) who can use them simultaneously. There are approximately 45 to 65 children outside at one time which is less than half of the child able to enjoy the sandboxes. There are many other areas within the playground for the children to play, such as trikes, climbing equipment and a variety of outdoor toys.

Analysis:

The Brockton Child Care Centre serves a diverse group of children, offering a safe and nurturing environment for their growth and development. The facility includes outdoor play areas that are crucial for children's physical activity and social interaction. However, these areas are currently lacking adequate sun protection. The absence of sunshade structures exposes children and staff to prolonged sun exposure, which poses health risks.

Historically, the Bruce-Grey Catholic District School Board had specific parameters regarding the construction of shade structures in the playgrounds. As a result, the Centre has used pop-up tents and temporary awnings

to provide some relief from sun exposure. While these solutions offer partial coverage, they do not adequately cover the sandboxes, leaving children and staff exposed to the sun during playtime.

Staff propose enlarging the two sandboxes and installing high-quality, durable sunshade structures specifically designed to cover the sandboxes in the Brockton Child Care Centre playgrounds. These structures and increased size of the sandbox will be permanent and compliant with the Bruce-Grey Catholic District School Board's requirements, ensuring long-term safety and comfort for the children.

Bruce County Social Services has generously provided a grant for the Centre to purchase essential items for programming. The total cost to enlarge the two sandboxes and build shade structures over the sandboxes would be covered by the grant received from Bruce County Social Services (\$10,400 + HST). Staff are bringing forward this request as the sandboxes and sunshade are capital purchases that were not proposed in the budget.

The installation of sunshade structures at the Brockton Child Care Centre is a critical step towards ensuring a safer and more comfortable environment for our children and staff. By approving this request, the County will demonstrate its dedication to protecting and nurturing its youngest residents and ongoing support to the Brockton Child Care Centre.
