Recommendation:

That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number PLN2024-06 - 37 Yonge Street Development Update – Traffic Safety Assessment, prepared by Dieter Weltz, Building and Planning Manager/CBO and Nicholas Schnurr, Director of Operations for information purposes and in doing so supports the recommendations presented within the Traffic Safety Assessment for the proposed development at 37 Yonge Street, Walkerton, with a By-Law to be brought forward at a future Council Meeting to amend the Traffic and Parking By-Law after completion and approval of the Site Plan Agreement.

Report:

Background:

The subject property and proposed Residential Development at 37 Yonge Street, Walkerton has been revised as the property is under new ownership with the proposal increasing in density from the original site plan approval of nine row townhouse units to thirty stacked row townhouse units. The subject property from the time of the previous site plan approval has seen in an increase in total lot area from the lot addition consent application and approval under Bruce County Planning File Number B-2022-054.

Analysis:

The proposed amended site plan design because of the increase in lot area and the increase in density from nine units to thirty staff has been subject to a new site plan application and approval with complete review of the proposed revised site plan.

Municipal Staff and our consulting engineers requested as part of the revised site plan a traffic safety assessment be prepared and undertaken. The Developer obtained the services of TNS – True North Safety

Group Incorporated who submitted and provided requested report dated June 5th 2024 which is attached to this report.

The conclusion of the report as result of the proposed development is for an all way stop to be implemented at the intersection of Yonge Street and Valleyside Drive with sidewalk extensions on the west side of Yonge Street extending to the intersection.

At the time of this report Municipal Staff are finalizing the draft Site Plan Control Agreement which will incorporate full securities being provided by the Developer for the external works including works associated with the all-way stop.

We bring this to Council's attention for information purposes.
