

# The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton



## By-Law 2019-024

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Being a By-Law to Amend By-Law 2018-096 to Establish, Ratify and Impose Fees and Charges for Goods and Services Provided By the Municipality of Brockton.

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**Whereas** the *Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c 25, Section 5(3)*, as amended provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by By-Law;

**And Whereas** the *Municipal Act, 2001, Chapter 25, Section 391(1)* authorizes a municipality to impose fees or charges on any class of persons,

- a) for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;
- b) for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board; and
- c) for the use of its property including property under its control.

**And Whereas** Municipal Councils have the authority to establish rates and fees under various Acts, and the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton deems it expedient to pass a by-law establishing certain fees and charges;

**And Whereas** the *Municipal Act, 2001, Chapter 25, Section 398 (2)* authorizes the treasurer of a local municipality to add fees and charges imposed by the municipality or local board, to the tax roll for the real property for which the owner or owners are responsible for paying the fees and charges;

**Now Therefore** the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows:

- 1.0 That The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton Council hereby amend Schedule "A" of By-Law 2018-086 to include that a Roads Infrastructure Fee of \$50.00 per household is to be added to municipal residents' tax bills for road infrastructure renewal in both urban and rural areas of the municipality.
- 2.0 That The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton Council hereby amend Schedule "B" of By-Law 2018-086 to include that a Hydrant Fee of \$1.00 per household is to be added to municipal residents' utility bills to off-set operating and capital costs of the winter maintenance of fire hydrants.
- 3.0 This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 4.0 This By-Law may be cited as the "Amend 2019 Fees and Charges By-Law".
