Recommendation:

That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby receives Report Number PW2025-05 – 2025 Equipment Tender Results – Tandem Axle Plow Truck, prepared by Nicholas Schnurr, Director of Operations, and in doing so, approves the immediate ordering of the 2025 Tandem Axle Diesel Powered Truck at a cost of \$201,513.85 plus HST, and further acknowledges that staff will use a Canoe Certified Vendor for the purchase of the box, spreader and attachments upon delivery of the cab and chassis, as per Brockton’s procurement policy.

Report:

Background:

In the 2025 budget deliberations, council approved \$350,000 for the purchase of a new tandem axle plow truck. These funds were allocated for the purchase of the cab and chassis plus the purchase of the box, spreader, and plow attachments.

A formal Request for Tender (RFT) for a Plow Truck Cab and Chassis was prepared and issued in March 2025. The RFT was distributed to qualified companies with a closing date of March 31, 2025. Brockton received two (2) submissions. Lewis Motor Sales Inc submitted a bid that qualified and followed the parameters of the tender.

A second compliant submission was also received from Premier Truck in the amount of \$214,634.00

Analysis:

Staff are recommending the immediate ordering of the Tandem Axle Diesel Powered Truck at a cost of \$201,513.85 plus HST. Staff also note that the plow equipment and attachments will be procured through Canoe and will come from Viking-Cives in Mount Forest. The estimated cost of the equipment to outfit the plow is \$175,000. All equipment to outfit the truck is made locally in Mount Forest.
