### Report:

### **Background:**

Yearly, the Municipality contracts out grass cutting services on a number of Municipally owned properties. This year, 26 properties are going to be serviced through this contract. Staff put out an RFQ to the previously two lowest bidders to have this work completed as per the Brockton procurement process.

#### **2025 Grass Cutting Quote Results**

Company Name	Monthly Total
Waughtertite	\$7,700 + HST
Scott SedImeir	\$11,760 +HST

Properties include public works yards, remote parklands, water towers, wells, landfills and the majority of the abandoned cemeteries as well as Starkvale Cemetery. The quote provided is in line with the 2024 actual costs.

#### **Analysis**:

Staff recommend that the Council of the Municipality of Brockton accept and award the contract to the lowest bidder, Waughtertite, at a cost of \$7,700+ HST per month, which is included in the 2025 operations budgets.
