Hello,

You are receiving this email as a participant in the integrated assessment of the proposed Bruce C Nuclear Project (the Project), located in the Municipality of Kincardine, Ontario.

On December 20, 2024, the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) issued its [decision](#) that an impact assessment is required for the Project proposed by Bruce Power (the proponent). This assessment will be an integrated assessment conducted in collaboration with the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC), which [has been referred](#) to an independent review panel.

On June 12, 2025, the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) issued a [Notice of Time Limit Resumption](#), to inform participants that the 180-day time limit for the Planning phase of the impact assessment for the proposed Bruce C Nuclear Project has resumed as of June 12, 2025.

As part of the Planning phase in the integrated assessment process, we now invite you to review and provide comments on the following draft documents:

- the draft [Integrated Tailored Impact Statement Guidelines](#) (draft Integrated Guidelines); and
- the draft [Public Participation Plan](#).

The draft Integrated Guidelines outline the specific factors to be considered in the assessment of the Project and provide direction to the proponent on the studies and information required in its Impact Statement.

The draft Public Participation Plan explains how the public will be engaged throughout the review process and provides details on how and when public participation opportunities will take place for each phase of the integrated assessment.
