#### Detachment Updates

- 2 new recruits joined our team in 2018. We also have four more recruits who just joined us in March and two more coming in May.
- In 2018 our Community Street Crime Unit was fully formed. This Unit has been addressing Drug and Property Crimes in our area.
- We participated fully in all the Provincial Traffic Initiatives in 2018 laying numerous Traffic related charges throughout the year.
- Our officers continue to enhance their knowledge through training. This year saw them attending "Mental Health First Aid", "Trauma Informed Investigation" and on-line training regarding the new Marijuana Legislation and Impaired Driving Legislation.

#### Detachment Updates

- The Marijuana Legislation has not shown us a significant increase in enforcement activity since October 17<sup>th</sup>, but we have processed two Impaired by Drug investigations since that time.
- The Pocket Your Keys Campaign was launched in the spring of 2018. This Campaign reminds community members to take their keys out of their vehicles and lock them. We encourage people to assist us in preventing crime.
- OPP members are the co-chairs of the County Safe Communities Committee which received it's designation as a "Safe Community" from Parachute Canada in the fall of 2018.

#### Detachment Updates

 We continue to participate in the Collaborative Situation Tables that consist of community partners from Canadian Mental Health Association, Victim Services, County Housing, Child and Family Services, Keystone Services. This group's goal is to review situations that exhibit acute elevated risks and create an intervention in hopes of preventing victimization.
