Recommendation:

That the Council of the Municipality of Brockton hereby approve Report Number CLK2019-03 – Lang Municipal Drain Tender, prepared by Fiona Hamilton, Clerk and in doing approves a By-Law coming forward to accept the tender of Robinson Farm Drainage Limited at a price of \$283,298.00 plus H.S.T. for the construction of the Lang Municipal Drain 2018.

Report:

Background:

On November 5, 2018, Council approved Resolution 18-21-390, which has been attached to this report, authorizing that new tenders be obtained for the construction of the Lang Municipal Drain 2018 as described in Greg Nancekivell's Engineering Report. The new instructions to tenderers was to specify an earlier starting date and end date to limit, to the extent possible, the damage to the landowners crops and has been attached to this report.

New tenders were received for the Lang Municipal Drain on February 15, 2019. The revised tender included the start and end date and specific provisional items in the Instructions to Tenderers for greater clarity. The Tenders were opened publicly with landowners, contractors and staff present.

The details of the two tenders that were received are summarized below:

Robinson Farm Drainage Limited

Total Construction Cost before HST: \$283,298.00

Time Period: Beginning after April 1, 2019 and Completed on or before May 15, 2019

Marquardt Farm Drainage Limited

Total Construction Cost before HST \$353,741.00

Time Period: Beginning after April 1, 2019 and Completed on or before May 15, 2019 (Weather permitting)

Both Robinson Farm Drainage Limited and Marquardt Farm Drainage Limited provided certified cheques for the deposit funds in compliance with the Instructions to Tenderers. The instructions to Tenderers also contained a provision stating "Lowest or any Tender not necessarily accepted".

Analysis:

Greg Nancekivell of Dietrich Engineering reviewed both tenders that were submitted for the construction of the Lang Municipal Drain 2018 (including an analysis of the provisional items) and is recommending that the Council of the Municipality of Brockton award the tender to Robinson Farm Drainage Limited.
