Subject: Request for membership on the *Regional Liaison Committee: Nuclear Economic Development and Innovation*

Bruce Power and the County of Bruce are establishing a **Regional Liaison Committee** to replace the former Nuclear Industry Advisory Committee that supports and advances the Nuclear Economic Development and Innovation Initiative.

In September 2016, a Nuclear Industry Regional Advisory Committee was established, made up of a number of regional representatives, to support the development of a strategic plan and interim actions to advance the Nuclear Economic Development and Innovation Initiative.

The Advisory Committee met several times since 2016 and achieved a number of objectives including:

- the development and successful execution of a Nuclear Industry Investment Strategy;
- supporting the navigation of the nuclear supply chain into the region;
- advancing training opportunities through the Local Training Action Team, and
- the development of a New Resident Tool Kit through the Welcoming Communities' Action Team.
