Report:

Background:

On Wednesday, April 24, 2019 Bruce County and BM Ross will be conducting a soffit inspection on the Durham Street Bridge. A hydraulic platform will be used over the south railing and due to where the fish are placed (in line with the interior expansion joints) BM Ross and Bruce County has asked the fish be temporarily removed.

Analysis:

The Public Works Department will remove the two fish sculptures along the south side and with the assistance of the Recreation Department the flower boxes on the bridge will also be removed in advance of April 24, 2019. The fish sculptures and flower boxes will be placed back on the bridge after the inspection is completed.
