

The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton



By-Law 2025-108

Being a By-Law to Amend the Response Criteria Appendix to the Tiered Response Agreement Between Bruce County EMS, the Municipality of Brockton, and the Municipality of West Grey.

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, Section 5(1), as amended, provides that the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its council;

And Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, Section 5(3), as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity rights, powers and privileges under section 9; shall be exercised by By-Law;

And Whereas on March 23, 2009 the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton passed By-Law 2009-20, entering into a Letter of Agreement between the County of Bruce, the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton, and the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey for the activation of tiered response of the Walkerton Fire Station to assist Bruce County Emergency Medical Services (EMS);

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton deems it expedient to amend the Appendix to the Agreement, being the Tiered Response Criteria for the Walkerton Fire Department;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows;

- 1.0 That The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton Council hereby amends the Appendix to the Tiered Response Agreement Between the Corporation of the County of Bruce, the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton and Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey, which is attached as "Schedule A" and forms part of this By-Law;
- 2.0 That the Appendix to By-Law 2009-20 be hereby amended.
- 3.0 This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 4.0 This By-Law may be cited as the "Amend Appendix to Bruce County EMS Tiered Response Agreement By-Law".
