By-Law 2026-003

Being a By-Law to Rescind Outdated Policies

Whereas the *Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c 25, Section 5(3)*, as amended provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by By-Law;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Fundraising by Volunteer Road Toll Policy M03-99-04 on January 1, 1999 and no longer require this policy as the practice was discontinued;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Break Open Ticket (BOT) Licensing Policy P09-2000-04 on January 1, 2000 and no longer require this policy as the Municipality follows the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario's Lottery Licensing Policies;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Rental of Municipal Buildings Policy A21-2001-02 on April 9, 2001, and no longer require this policy as this process was discontinued.

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Souvenir Disbursement Policy A00-2001-05 on July 23, 2001 and no longer require this policy as the practice has changed;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Refund Policy for Watershed Campers R04-2003-01 on October 15, 2003 and no longer require this policy as the Watershed Festival was discontinued;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Leasing Unused Municipal Buildings Policy A21-2004-01 on January 1, 2004 and no longer require this policy as both buildings mentioned in the policy are no longer owned by the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Statement of Lease Financing Policies and Goals Policy A21-2006-04 in April 2006 and no longer requires this Policy as the process has changed;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Cheque-Account Listing Disclosure Policy F07-0500-15 on July 27, 2014 as per By-Law 2015-060, and no longer require this Policy as the Procedural By-Law was amended on November 25, 2025 as per By-Law 2025-100, removing this item from Council Meeting Agendas;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Nuclear Waste Management Organization Community Well Being Grants Policy F11-0500-16 on June 6, 2016 as per By-Law 2016-040 and no longer require this policy as this grant was discontinued;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton formerly adopted a Budget Process Policy F05-0500-17 on May 23, 2017 as per By-Law 2017-047, and no longer require this policy due to the process changing as a result of Strong Mayor Powers under O. Reg 530/22: Part VI.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, c.25;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows:

- 1.0 That Policies M03-99-04 P09-2000-04, A00-2001-05, A21-2001-02, R04-2003-01, A21-2004-01, A21-2006-04, F07-0500-15, F11-0500-16, and F05-0500-17, and By-Laws 2015-060, 2016-040, and 2017-047 be hereby rescinded.
- 2.0 This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 3.0 This By-Law may be cited as the "Rescind Outdated Policies By-Law".
