

The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton



By-Law 2026-002

Being a By-Law to Rescind the Partnership Agreement with Cleanfarms for the Purpose of Collecting Bale Wrap in the Municipality of Brockton.

Whereas the *Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c 25, Section 5(3)*, as amended provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by By-Law;

And Whereas prior to April 1, 2024 Cleanfarms had been operating a program for the recovery and reclamation of bale wrap in collaboration with municipalities in Bruce County for the benefit of participating farmers;

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton entered into a Partnership Agreement with Cleanfarms on April 9, 2024 as per By-Law 2024-029 to continue collecting bale wrap within the Municipality of Brockton;

And Whereas Cleanfarms has discontinued this program and the Municipality of Brockton wishes to rescind the former Partnership Agreement;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows:

- 1.0 That the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton Council hereby authorizes rescinding the Partnership Agreement with Cleanfarms.
- 2.0 That By-law 2024-029 be hereby rescinded.
- 3.0 This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 4.0 This By-Law may be cited as the "Rescind Cleanfarms Agreement By-Law".
