By-Law 2026-006

Being a By-Law to Authorize the Corporation of the County of Bruce to Collect the Dedicated Gas Tax Funds Allocation From the Ministry of Transportation

Whereas Saugeen Mobility and Regional Transit (S.M.A.R.T.) operates a disabled transit service in the municipalities of Arran-Elderslie, Brockton, Chatsworth, Grey Highlands, Hanover, Huron-Kinloss, Kincardine, Saugeen Shores, Southgate and West Grey;

And Whereas the Corporation of the County of Bruce is the host municipality for the receipt of the Dedicated Gas Tax Funds for Public Transportation Program for S.M.A.R.T. on behalf of the member municipalities;

And Whereas the Province of Ontario requires a by-law from the member municipalities involved in a jointly provided public transportation service agreeing to the Corporation of the County of Bruce collecting the Dedicated Gas Tax Funds on their behalf;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton enacts as follows:

- 1.0 That the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton authorizes the Corporation of the County of Bruce to collect the Dedicated Gas Tax Funds from the Ministry of Transportation on their behalf.
- 2.0 That the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton agrees that the funds received under the Dedicated Gas Tax Funds for Public Transportation Program will be used in accordance with the Guidelines and Requirements issued by the Ministry of Transportation.
- 3.0 This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 4.0 This By-Law may be cited as the "Authorize County of Bruce to Collect Dedicated Gas Tax Funds SMART By-Law".
