By-Law 2026-010

Being a By-Law to Appoint _____ to Fill the Vacancy in the Office of Councillor for the Municipality of Brockton.

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Section 5(1)*, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its council;

And Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Section 5(3)*, as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity rights, powers and privileges under section 9; shall be exercised by By-Law;

And Whereas by reason of resignation of Councillor B. Carl Kuhnke effective November 6, 2025, it is deemed expedient to fill the vacancy in the Office of Councillor for the Municipality of Brockton, resulting from the abovementioned resignation;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton declared B. Carl Kuhnke's former Councillor seat vacant on November 25, 2025;

And Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Section 263 (1.A)*, as amended provides that the municipality may fill the vacancy of a member of council by appointing a person who has consented to accept the office if appointed;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton has completed its process to fill a vacancy on Council in accordance with its Council Vacancy Replacement Policy;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton has appointed _____ to fill the Councillor Office for the remainder of the term thereof;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Brockton **Enacts as Follows:**

- 1.0 That _____ be and is hereby appointed to fill the office of Councillor for the Municipality of Brockton for the remainder of the 2022-2026 term.
- 2.0 That this By-Law shall come into effect upon final passage.
- 3.0 This By-Law may be cited as the "Appoint _____ as Councillor By-Law".
